But then, occasionally, there comes a band that does it a little better and a little different than their peers. Geoff Palmer and his band are that band. The songs are short, expertly well-crafted, and ultra-catchy pop gems. They are loud, humorous, and fun-loving—simply put, they produce great music. "We make up songs for the good times, we make up songs for the bad times to make them good times, we make up songs, and people sing along, at least I hope they do!" Palmer says, and indeed, the audiences do join in! History: In 2019, Geoff launched his solo career with the album "Pulling Out All the Stops," released through Stardumb Records. The debut LP was met with critical acclaim and became a global success, resonating with both power pop and punk fans. From the start, it was clear that it was something special. Palmer and his band quickly released more albums, showcasing his talent for songwriting. A dynamic force in pop punk, punk, garage rock, and power pop, Geoff Palmer hails from Portsmouth, NH, but is now based in Madison, WI. Palmer's infectious melodies and high-energy songs first gained notoriety as a member of the pop-punk band The Guts. Their world tours and the celebrated album "Let It Go" solidified their place in the genre. He later worked with The Queers on their albums "Everything's OK" and "Punk Rock Confidential." As a founding member of the veteran garage rock and power pop band The Connection, Geoff consistently showcased his knack for crafting catchy tunes. He has also embraced collaboration throughout his career, playing pivotal roles in the Kurt Baker Band and The New Trogadéros. Notably: Over ten of Geoff's songs have been named the "Coolest Song in the World" by Little Steven Van Zandt, the legendary figure in rock and roll radio. His music has appeared on SiriusXM's Faction Punk channel 314 and The Underground Garage channel 21, reaching listeners worldwide. His work has been featured in major outlets like HuffPost. Currently: Geoff is working on a four-song EP with producer Mike Kennerty from the All-American Rejects, set to be released on Stardumb Records in early 2025. This EP promises to kick ass as always, mixing pop-punk and garage rock, showing Geoff's diverse songwriting skills. With his strong history in music and a passion for creating enjoyable songs, Geoff Palmer continues to be an essential figure in the industry. He shows no signs of stopping anytime soon!
